The student's details of address and phone numbers are entered into the School database, and remain confidential. Any change of address must be given to the Office. Mobile and after hours telephone numbers are required for emergency purposes only.

Attendance

All students are required to have 100% attendance at lectures.

Assessment

The Student is required to create a template for all documentation relevant to their usage and ready for use in the workforce, this is given a pass or fail mark. Failure to complete the assignment requirements to an acceptable level will result in failure to graduate. It is not compulsory for students to do the assignment, but certificates will only be issued to those who successfully completed the set testing criteria.

Graduation

After completion of the Course the Students will be required to submit an assignment for assessment. On successful completion of this assessment a Certificate will be posted to the Student including the return of their assignment. There will be a delay between receipt of the Student's assessment and them receiving their Certificate of approximately two months.

Course Availability

The Project Management Course in Interior Design & Decorating is held in small groups upon request.

The course curriculum is provided prior to the session so that the student may read the information in preparation for discussion during the session. It is recommended that 2-3 weeks be allowed for this process. One session is mandatory with a further session after implementation if required.
